Présentation des bourses

- Deux types de bourses :
 - 5 bourses d'un an, de septembre 2012 à août 2013
 - 20 bourses d'un mois, de décembre 2012 à janvier 2013
- Conditions : Être âgé de moins de 20 ans et posséder des bases linguistiques en mandarin.
- Les sélections ont déjà été effectuées par une commission, avec l'aide des professeurs de mandarin, et des chefs d'établissement.
- La scolarité, l'hébergement et la nourriture tout au long des séjours seront pris en charge par le lycée international WENLING.
- Le ministère prévoit d'octroyer une subvention de 2,5 millions de francs pacifique pour aider les 25 familles à financer le transport aérien.

Un partenariat entre plusieurs acteurs


- Cet échange a été mis en place par une convention signée entre le Pays et la République populaire de Chine.
- L'association WENFA et l'association d'amitié sino-polynésienne ont grandement contribué à la réussite de ce projet.
- La compagnie aérienne Air Tahiti Nui a elle aussi participé en proposant aux étudiants des tarifs préférentiels (124 295 XPF pour le séjour d'un mois et 165 895 XPF pour le séjour d'un an)
- L'association Hei Taina, composée de parents d'élèves boursiers, a été créée pour accompagner les familles dans les démarches administratives (Visa, assurance, etc.)



Introduction to Wenling High School

Wenling High School, established during the Qing Dynasty in 1848, is one of Zhejiang's key high schools. After being relocated five times and renamed five, it has developed into its current three campuses located at Wenling's Wulong Science Area—Wenling High School, WHS, Wenling Experimental Junior School, and the International Department. WHS boasts first-class teaching facilities and covers approximately 27 hectares with a total floor space of 140,000 square meters.

WHS has performed excellently well in the college entrance examination, especially since its recent relocation in 2001. Its high reputation is evident by its many titles which include "Provincial Civilization Unit," "Provincial Advanced Primary Party Branch," "Provincial Civilization School," and "Provincial Advanced Security School." It was classified as an "Inquiry-based Learning Experimental School" by the Ministry of Education's Basic Education Department, as well as the "Zhejiang University Educational Practice Base." In 2002 it was honored to be among "the top one hundred famous schools with a history of a hundred years in Zhejiang Province."

"Diligence and Enterprise, Truth and Precision." In order to uphold this motto, WHS focuses on cultivating the student primarily in ideological and ethical standards, scientific and cultural qualities, as well as all-around physical wellness. In the past half-century, the school has produced about 50,000 graduates, including Zhan Ke and Banghe, 11, the academicians of the Chinese Academy of Sciences, Ding Cai, the academicians of the Chinese Academy of Engineering. Among them is Professor Binbin Wang, who is an educationist, artist and poet.

Wenling High School has an excellent teaching staff, including one teacher awarded the Lifetime Achievement Award, 2 model workers of the province, 28 masters, 2 Traditional Subject Qualification, 110 senior teachers. The headmaster, Caiqi Chen, who is currently working on his Ph.D., was awarded the National May 1 Labor Medal and the State Department Special Allowance, enjoying great prestige in chemistry education and school management both at home and abroad.

WHS also stands out with multimedia facilities in every classroom, and a multimedia digital library with a volume of 146,000 books and advanced school network. Its local area network with about 1,000 computers has distinguished the school by improving its teaching and managing efficiency. It was chosen as the provincial experimental school of information technology and is the first high school in Taizhou to utilize the Internet and China Education Web.

Wenling High School pays much attention to foreign exchange and cooperation. It maintains friendly relations with schools around the world, including the United States, Japan, Australia, Britain, Canada, Russia, Korea, and Malaysia. It is qualified for engaging foreign teachers and students. Moreover, it has the qualifications to recommend students for immediate admission to Beijing University, Tsinghua University, and Zhejiang University. Since the introduction of a new curriculum in 2006, WHS has been focusing on the new idea of "Harmonious Education" to further promote its level of quality and distinguish its own school culture with humanity as the core, continually striving toward the goal of both a first-class and international-level model high school.




